Who Are We

The Community Living Association for South Simcoe (CLASS) supports people with a developmental disability.

CLASS is a non-profit, charitable organization governed by a volunteer Board of Directors. The agency was established in 1962 by a group of parents who wanted services in their own community for their children who had a diagnosis of a developmental disability.



Our Services

PASSAGES

(ADULT FEE FOR SERVICE)

Passages helps people with developmental disabilities build on their strengths and interests through community opportunities, focusing on independence, social skills, employment, volunteering, and recreation. Fees vary by support level.

SERVICES FOR YOUNG ADULTS

Facilitating Youth Involvement (FYI) is a weekday after-school program for high school students offering recreation, leisure, and educational activities based on their interests and needs.

ADULT ACCOMODATION SUPPORTS

CLASS provides accommodation supports for adults with developmental disabilities, including group living, family home, and shared or private options with staff as needed.

COMMUNITY DAY SUPPORTS

CLASS offers programs for people with developmental disabilities to help them reach their goals, including community access, education, recreation, volunteering, life skills, and employment.

Fundraising Programs



CLASSic Lunchbox in partnership with The Everett Legion offers employment readiness programs and serves up home-made soup weekly.



CLASSy Canine Cookies is a program run through the Resource Centre. The biscuits are all natural and sold at local retailers.



CLASSy Creations provides employment skills for people and creates glassware, art and other products for sale.
