

<u>Alliston Facilitating Youth Involvement</u> <u>Summer Program 2023</u>

- 1) If you are new to CLASS you must contact <u>heatherbarzo@class.on.ca</u> to complete an intake before signing up for program.
- 2) Cost of program is \$50 a day plus the activity fee outlined on the schedule.
- 3) Families are required to pre-register for Camp to ensure needs are met. Registration is needed by June 1, 2023. Please email <u>heatherbarzo@class.on.ca</u> the dates the youth is wanting to attend. You will be contacted by June 15th if there are any dates the program has filled up and your teen is unable to attend.
- 4) Transportation to and from the program is the responsibility of the family. All pick-ups and drop offs are at CLASS, 125 Dufferin Street. Punctuality with arriving and departures are mandatory. Drop off-9:00 am. Pick up: 4:00 pm.
- 5) Teens are required to bring their own lunches, snacks, and sufficient drinks to keep them hydrated throughout a busy day.
- 6) Teens are required to wear appropriate footwear and clothes for the daily activities.
- 7) Schedules may change due to weather and interest of those in attendance.
- 8) Teens will be expected to bring pocket money.
- 9) Families will be invoiced for a month at a time.
- 10) All teens must be double vaccinated for COVID 19 to attend. CLASS needs proof of the vaccinations.
- 11) CLASS follows Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services guidelines regarding COVID 19 restrictions and mask mandates.
